Our College has been recognized by the ERC/NCTE vide order dated 19.05.2009 with 100 annual intake of students. Thereafter, L.N. Mithila University, Darbhanga has granted permanent affiliation vide their notification dated 26.05.2012. Our institution has been declared as Minority Institution under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of India and within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Institution Act, 2004.</p>
